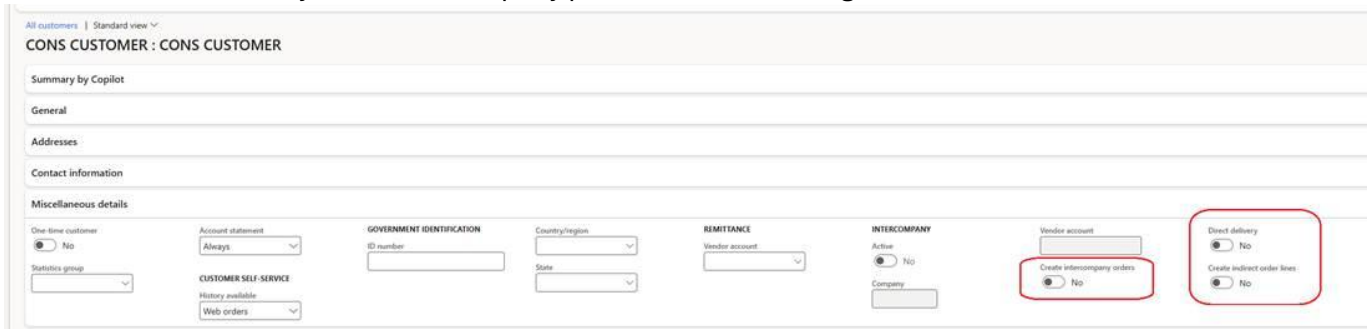

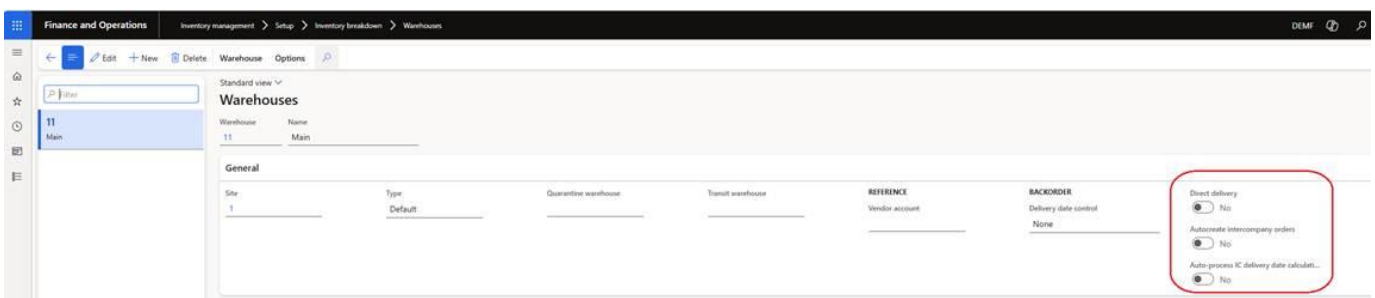
a. Axcite Sales

In standard functionality the 3 intercompany parameters are managed in customer master data:



With this Axcite sales module release the 3 intercompany parameters are now managed from the warehouse instead.

If you use intercompany setup, please go to Inventory management/Inventory breakdown/ Warehouse in the selling intercompany and set up the parameters you used to have set up on the customers:

8. January 2025 release

a. Warehouse Management

MHAX integration has been rewritten to decouple Kardex integration from Dynamics 365 FnO.

This requires special attention if using previous versions of Warehouse Management Kardex integration or integrations build on top of the Kardex integration.

9.October 2024 release – No updates required

No actions required.

10. April 2024 release

a. EDI

With this release the BizBrains integration no longer supports SOAP and is reimplemented using the REST based API. The communication with BizBrains is moved out of D365FO and into Azure.

The following actions must be taken:

- Before going live on this release all existing BizBrains documents must have been processed, and integration must be stopped.
- At BizBrains, REST API must be enabled for the customer.
- The Azure Integration solution must be installed.
- Business Event Endpoint must be setup (Azure Blob Storage).
- Batch job for processing inbound messages must be created.
